- ☐ Your proposed travel route (at least 3 cities in 2 countries)
- ☐ Your idea for creative documentation (e.g., vlog, photo essay, sketchbook)

- A digital poster with illustrations and travel quotes



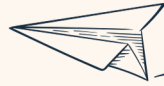

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



○ **What is World Heritage?**

A unique cultural or natural site of outstanding value to humanity, protected for future generations.

○ **What cities can I visit?**

You can visit all cities, but 3 of them have to be OWHC cities

○ **How can I travel?**

By train, bus, preferably sustainable methods – within your budget.

○ **Is insurance included?**

No, we recommend purchasing your own travel insurance.

○ **Can I apply if I am not a student?**

Yes! The program is open to all young people aged 18 to 28, students or not.

○ **Do I have to pay to participate?**

No, participation is free.

Can I apply with friends? Yes, you can apply as a team.
